The Gloucester Skating Club is hosting its annual club competition at the Bob MacQuarrie Complex on **Saturday**, **April 2oth**, **2024**. All eligible skaters are encouraged to participate. This is a fun day for all skaters!

BASIC RULES FOR THE COMPETITION

Skaters must be registered as a 2023-24 GSC skater.
 GSC and Non-GSC skaters may participate in Team Elements, Creative Improv, Team Showcase and Parent/Skater Showcase.

2. Entry fees:

\$30.00 for each - STAR 1 Assessment, STAR 2-4 Free Skate, Creative Improvisation, Artistic events

\$30.00/skater - Adult / Teen / RECSkate

\$15.00/skater - Team Elements

\$15.00/skater - Team Showcase, or Parent/ Skater event

- 3. Consult with your Base Coach to determine what events to register in. Then register on-line by 11:59pm on Friday April 5th, 2024 NO Late entries will be accepted!
- 4. Events may be cancelled or combined depending on the number of entries.
- 5. There will be no refunds for withdrawals except for a cancelled event.
- 6. Test Qualifications are as of **January 31st**, **2024** and Age Qualifications are as of **January 31st**, **2024**.
- 7. There will be draws for all events to determine skating orders.
- 8. STAR 1 3 will receive the STARSkate assessment and ribbons.

STAR 4 will receive medals and results will be posted.

All other events will receive medals and results will be posted.

Presentations will be held on the day of the competition.

Full skating attire is required for medal presentations.

- 9. Whenever eligibility for an event is specific in terms of a test, it shall mean the **COMPLETE** test.
- 10. All skaters must be in the rink at least ONE HOUR prior to the start of his/her event except for the first event of the day, in which case, 1/2 HOUR prior is sufficient. All skaters must confirm their presence with the ice captain.
- 11. All solo music will be put on the GSC iPad. Please ensure your Base Coach takes care of this.

SHOWCASE EVENTS

Showcase programs are designed by the skaters to focus on entertaining an audience through use of theatrics or artistic abilities. Programs may tell a story, create a mood or have an obvious theme.

Costumes and props are permitted within the restrictions.

There are 4 options for this event.

1 skater - Individual Showcase

2-6 skaters - Group Showcase

7 or more skaters - Production Showcase
Parent & Skater Showcase

Additional Notes for this event:

- Theatrical costumes and hand props are permitted. Feathers and boas of any type are not permitted.
- Vocal music is permitted.
- A maximum of 1 minute will be permitted prior to each performance for the skater(s) to warm-up and set-up any props as necessary.
- All single jumps are permitted. Jumps of any higher rotation will be subject to an illegal element violation if included.

Group and/or Production events:

- Group routines must have between two and six skaters. All participants must wear skates.
- Production routines must have seven or more skaters. All participants must wear skates.
- Program should not resemble a Synchronized Skating program. Use of team formations and maneuvers should be limited.
- Lifts and throws of any kind are not permitted. Inclusion of such elements will be subject to an illegal element violation.
