





Novice Team Level

SENIOR TEAM:

The Senior Team, which was fourth in Canada in 1981, climbed to the second position in 1982, being finalist at the Canadian International Competition.

JUNIOR TEAM:

This team was first at Ontario Sectional in February, a Bronze Medal with a th finish at the Canadian Individual Competition held in April against teams from Canada and United States. It is to be noted that all 18 girls were also members of Senior Team which won Medal in their category.

NOVICE TEAM (under 16)

This group of young ladies first at the Eastern Ontario Figure Skating Association competition in February 1982, and the only group to do so. They did not place at the National Figure Skating Association competition because the Canadian Figure Skating Association did not hold a national competition in 1982.


February 27, 2021
