Kadavy had also competed at the 1988 Winter Olympics, but had to withdraw before the long program due to the same flu that almost took out Liz Manley. Caryn spent the day working with all-levels of GSC skaters.

Robert 'Bob' McAvoy - The man, the myth, the legend!... and GSC's first coach!

Bob was a very successful skater, whose accolades included the 1966 Canadian Novice Pairs Bronze Medal with partner Mary Petrie, the 1966 Canadian Novice Men's Silver medal, the 1967 Canadian Junior Pairs Silver medal with Mary Petrie, and the 1969 Canadian Senior Pairs Silver Medal again with partner Mary Petrie. Also in 1969 he and Mary were one of the first Canadian pairs to successfully land the new 'throw axel' at the Grand Prix Competition in St Gervais France, after it was no longer a banned move. They went on to become the 1969 North American Championship Bronze medalists, and then the 1970 Canadian Senior pairs silver medalists, earning them a place on the Canadian World Team, where they placed 15th in Ljubijana, Yugoslavia. The following year, Bob became one of Gloucester's first coaches when the club began in 1971. He was a very successful coach, with many wonderful skaters, including the club's first skater (Micheline Rioux) to a National Championship. He started the club's 1st competitive program and within 5 years of coaching Elizabeth Manley, she was also competing at the National level. He left the club in 1983, but his legacy lives on, because he is the reason the club is what it is today! [#GSC](#) [#GSCis50](#) [#skating](#)

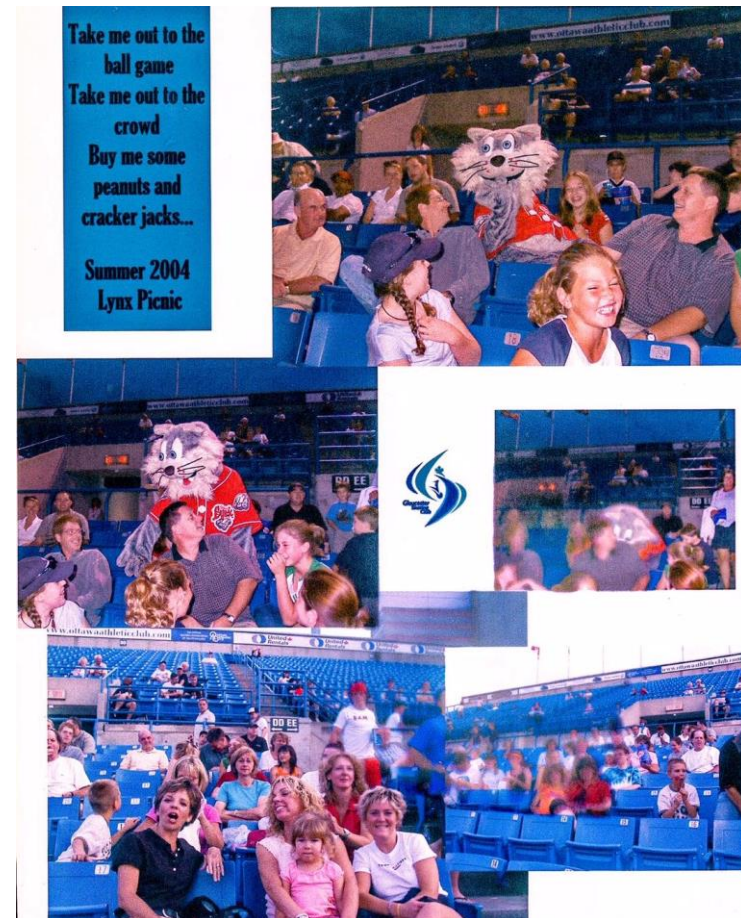
