INFORMATION SHEET FOR PARENTS AND SKATERS

STARSkate QUALIFYING LEVELS: (BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD, Pre-Comp, Competitive)

Skaters must register at the level they are qualified to skate. Our qualifying levels were revised April 12, 2017. Before registering, please review the [Programs and Progression Chart](#) on the STARSkate Program tab. After the registration due date, skaters may add sessions at the next lower level if space permits. GSC reserves the right to move skaters between levels depending on skill, date of qualifying tests and number of skaters registered.

***PRE-COMP** skaters require 11 Skate Canada FreeSkate test points to attend **GOLD** sessions.

COMPETITIVE TRAINING ICE: Speak to your Base Coach before registering to understand requirements for competitive training ice.

CHANGES: Email change requests to the Club Office at info@gloucesterskatingclub.ca by Thursday night before the skating week that starts on Saturday to Friday. Skaters may add sessions at any time online and the fee will be prorated by the number of classes remaining in the session.

ATTENDANCE: Skaters will be signed-in at each skating session BY THE MUSIC PLAYER. If not on the attendance list, a skater will be asked to leave the ice until they are registered. A tablet will be kept in the music room if skaters need to register.
