### SKATE CANADA NATIONAL PROGRAMS

#### Badges – Teaching Progressions

There are six 'Stage' badges in the CANSKATE learn-to-skate program. Each Stage incorporates the "ABC's" of skating skills focusing on the fundamental movements of 'Agility', 'Balance', and 'Control'.

#### Pre-CanSkate – Age: 3-4 years

Children aged 3-4 years are taught basic skating fundamentals, with a focus on continuous movement and creative play.

#### CanSkate – Age: 4-6+ years

Children aged 4-6+ years are taught forward/backward skating and cross-cuts, stopping, balance, and turning, etc. Hockey and ringette players can also enhance their game by improving their skating skills with our program.

#### RecFigureSkate / Active For Life

Rec Figure skaters continue to develop figure skating skills in groups in a fun, recreational and safe environment. In Active for Life, Teen/Adult skaters learn skating skills from beginner to recreational figure skating.

### HELMET POLICY

Skate Canada clubs and skating schools who offer a CanSkate program must ensure ALL CANSKATE and ADULT CANSKATE skaters up to and including Stage 5 MUST wear a CSA APPROVED HOCKEY HELMET while on the ice.

**Register:** Go to [www.gloucesterskatingclub.ca](http://www.gloucesterskatingclub.ca) and click on GSC Registration/Store. We accept late registrations on a pro-rated basis if space permits. Registration instructions are found at the bottom of the Store/Registration webpage. **If this is your first time skating, type NEW when asked for your membership number. We will request a membership number for you and let you know when it is assigned by Skate Canada.** If you are a member and do not remember your membership number, please type **UNKNOWN**.

**Payment is due on registration.** Pay **online only** by Visa / Mastercard, online debit or eCheque.

**Refunds:** Cancel your registration prior to **April 1, 2018**. Registration **ONLY** (not membership or development fees) will be refunded less a \$25 administration fee. **There are NO REFUNDS after April 1, 2018.** There are no substitutions or make-ups for missed lessons. You may request a medical credit at any time if a doctor's note recommends the skater should not attend lessons. No administration fee applies for medical credits.

GSC may change or cancel sessions or ice time depending on registration and to accommodate special events or other emergency situations. The skating calendar for scheduled cancellations is posted on the GSC website and bulletin board.
